Dear Review Board:

It has been brought to our attention that the Canada Post Corporation Strategic Review, which was launched by the federal government on April 21st, 2008, is looking at deregulating our public post office (i.e. reducing or removing Canada Post's exclusive privilege on letters).

The Council of the Town of Creighton understands that it will become increasingly difficult for our public post office to provide affordable service to everyone, no matter where they live, if the government erodes or eliminates the very mechanism that funds universal postal service – the exclusive privilege.

We are concerned that the government's review includes an examination of deregulation. It is a known fact that postal deregulation in other countries has led to post office closures, less service, fewer jobs and higher postal rates for the public and small businesses.

The Council of the Town of Creighton wish to advise that we support our public Canada Post Office situated on Main Street and we do not want to lose this valuable service as this is our only mail provider.
