

Lettermail should be capped at inflation, not below it.

-Canada Post should not be required to have corporate installations in small communities, but should be mandated to establish franchises where possible as replacements and electronic postage as substitutes to postage stamps for letter mail

-The Government of Canada should offer individuals the option of being sent correspondence from the government via Epost instead of paper mail as a move towards being more green.

-Canada Post should be given the ability to finance modernization through increases through debt servicing and temporary suspension of dividends

-The auditor general should be required to assess the financial status of the corporation and recommend changes to make the service more sustainable

-Local delivery should be maintained, but only to the property line for single family dwellings, not to the door; multi-family complexes should have delivery to a central panel box, not to individual units.

-Grandfathering of services to older (e.g. delivery to each unit in older condo towers) should be discontinued
