RE: Submission to save universal public postal service

With respect to the above noted, please be advised that the council of The R.M. of Morris No. 312 feels that it is important to save universal, public postal service. The local post office provides excellent service, friendly staff, and the consistent postage rates outlined by Canada Post. It is only fair that postage from a rural location cost the same as postage from a larger urban location.

It has come to the attention of Council that postal deregulation in other locations has led to fewer jobs, less service and higher postal rates. A large concern is that these outcomes would affect the rural areas (where we are situated) first and most strongly.

Also brought to the attention of Council is the lack of public hearings regarding the post office review. It is the feeling of Council that a publicly owned corporation should seek public input for decision-making

Therefore, the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris No. 312 opposes deregulation of Canada Post, and requests that public hearing begin to be held for purposes of making this decision.
