WHEREAS the Canada Post Corporation Strategic Review, which was launched by the Federal Government on April 28, 2008, is looking at the deregulation of our public postal services;


AND WHEREAS postal deregulation in other countries has resulted in post office closures, less service, fewer jobs and higher postage rates for the public and small businesses;

AND WHEREAS the Federal Government is not currently holding public hearings as part of their review of the "Crown Corporation" which is financed by the taxes collected from Canadian ratepayers;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Rural Municipality of Mountain shall submit a letter to the Canada Post Corporation Strategic Review voicing their opposition to the deregulation of Canada Post and insisting that public hearings be held to allow the public an opportunity to express their opinion on the deregulation of postal services.
