To Whom It May Concern

It has been brought to the Town of Shelburne's attention that a Canada Post Corporation Strategic Review is being done. The Mayor and Councillors for the Town of Shelburne wish to express their concerns that a strategic review is being done without the public's input.

The postal service in the Town of Shelburne is an asset to the citizens of the Town. The present postal service has already had cutbacks, such as, cancelled Saturday deliveries and cutbacks on service hours. If deregulation is considered for the Town's postal service, the existing services may be threatened and/or not as professional as those being received now.

The Town of Shelburne supports the following resolution:

WHEREAS the Canada Post Corporation Strategic Review, which was launched by the federal government on April 21st, 2008, is looking at deregulating our public post office (i.e. Reducing or removing Canada Post's exclusive privilege on letters)


WHEREAS it will become increasingly difficult for our public post office to provide affordable service to everyone, no matter where they live, if the government erodes or eliminates the very mechanism that funds universal postal service – the exclusive privilege.

WHEREAS postal deregulation in other countries has led to postal office closures, less service, fewer jobs and higher postal rates for the public and small business.

WHEREAS the government is not holding public hearings as part of its strategic review or adequately consulting with the real owners of the post office -- the public.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Town of Shelburne sends a letter or submission to the Canada Post Corporation Strategic Review opposing deregulation of Canada Post and insisting that the government hold public hearings and properly consult with the true owners of Canada Post -- the public.
