

1. Canada Post currently did NOT deliver to the DOOR to ALL addresses, including remote area, town with low density (but not remote), most high-rise building, townhouse, house at new addresses, legal basement suite under municipal by-law.....
2. Since the same worker is processing mail/courier/parcel service, it IS cross-subsidizing. (even their accountant can break down the cost)
3. They already have all resources/flexibility they need. (They do more non-regulated services than regulated postal services AND make money)
4. Although Canadian need postal service, the name of the provider are not important.
5. If other company have privileges to provide postal service: They MUST be able to access existing pobox and setup new pobox. (All pobox will be accessible with all postal company) They MUST have access to apartment lobby/mail panel. They MUST be able to setup street furniture (to collect and relay mail) just like the existing postal company do.
6. "affordable, universal" service does not mean one rate to everywhere in Canada. Either it cost more to rural and/or different province, or service level goes down.
7. ALL postal company should provide universal postal service to remote areas. Monies may come from a surcharge of stamp or postage.
8. "bulk" rate should apply between postal company to possess last-mile delivery. (just like Canada Post pay Terminal due to foreign Countries)
9. All company should have chances to deal with postal body around the world in order to establish incoming/outgoing mail business. (NO exclusive privileges for international mail.) Failure to do so results in lost mail revenue within ALL posties globally due to internet/phone/email...
10. Blind material, magazine, newspaper, library book and foodmail should be funded by the Government. All postal/courier company should have equal opportunity to bid for the contracts.
11. At this time www.epost.ca claimed they SECURELY send/store email under CPC act. (It is federal offense under CPC act for temper with mail.) All other company should be able to "postmark" email. If Canada Post can do online business, so as other company.

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
