I live in Inuvik, Northwest Territories and as an avon representative rely heavily on the postal system to receive my product and then distribute it to communities further north.

So often consultations are done forgetting about the people living in Yukon, Northwest Territories or Nunavut. We may be small in numbers, but I bet we generate a good portion of the revenue with the rates we are charge to send parcels within the territory or to the south.

I receive very good service from our post office in Inuvik as well as good service for my product to come from Montreal (Although I did receive it frozen in the middle of August once!). My concern is the cost of the service. If you were to deregulate, the cost could double or triple.

Please consider some consultation from companies and residents who live in the far north and rely heavily on the postal service.
